## SCOTTISH GRAIN WHISKY

Grain whisky can be based on a variety of grains-not solely malted barley- and is distilled in huge continuous column stills. This speeds up the distillation process and creates a light and delicate spirit. Most of this production will be used for the Blended Whisky industry however sometimes a few extraordinary bottles of single grain whisky can be found.

### Carsebridge 48yo 1970, 43.2%, Lowlands

*This might very well be one of the last bottles of this long-closed distillery. As most of its production was used as a component for blended whiskies, only a few barrels remained to be released as a Single Grain Whisky. Aged entirely in American oak casks, notes of dried flowers, custard and orange oil are very evident.*

## IRISH WHISKEY

Traditionally closely linked to Scotch however very different in style. A mixture of malted & unmalted barley and a combination of pot stills and column stills give Irish whiskies their pronounced personality.
